ATR VERDICT: TONKINESE has the highest official rating in this claimer and has plenty going for him. He was a fair fifth in a better race over course and distance last month, has a lovely low draw and Mikey Sheehy claims a valuable 7lb from his back. Itsalonglongroad stayed on well to win a claimer over an extended 10 furlongs on his last visit to Dundalk, but it is worth noting that 12 previous attempts at this trip on the Polytrack haven't yielded any victories. Royal Admiral faces a tough task at these weights but is perfectly capable of picking up prize money. Swift Wing's first start for James McAuley saw him finish third behind Itsalonglongroad after doing his best work at the finish. He is an unexposed sort who showed some useful placed form in Britain for John Gosden and Tom Lacey, however, he would need to bounce back from a below-par run in eighth at this track on Monday.

ATR VERDICT: Casa Comigo has been in good form on all-weather surfaces in Britain and can be competitive on his first start for Leanne Breen, who is more than adept at winning with horses that switch to her. Casa Comigo has four victories from Lingfield and one at Kempton in his locker (all over approximately two miles, though). Joey Sheridan's 5lb claim puts PAK ARMY on an attractive mark. He races off 67 which was his last winning mark at Limerick in September. He didn't run badly off 72 when sixth, in a better race, over course and distance last month. He was just over a length behind the fourth horse who came out and spreadeagled the field in a maiden at this track on Monday. Storm Steps is chasing a course and distance hat-trick. A 3lb rise doesn't look excessive, so he ought to be on the premises. Dame Rapide has won three of her last four on the Polytrack and gets on well with 7lb claimer Siobhan Rutledge. An 8lb rise makes life trickier up in class, but she is an in-form mare worthy of respect. Ivy Avenue makes her all-weather debut after a recent third at the Curragh and could show up well.

ATR VERDICT: An each-way chance is taken on HERCULANEUM in a tricky race. Joseph O'Brien's charge began his career with a sixth place in a maiden at this racecourse in February that has thrown up a plethora of winners. He should be all the sharper for a fifth place in a heavy-ground maiden at the Curragh earlier in the month. Australia's progeny are showing up well on all-weather surfaces. Freepark was only 9/2 for his debut over course and distance last month. He was slowly into stride before finishing seventh and is likely to improve upon that. Stately Home was only pipped by a nose in that maiden, on his Irish debut, having been runner-up in two all-weather races at Lingfield. He ought to be in the mix again. Orchid Gardens doesn't know how to run a bad race. Incredibly, she has been placed in eight of her nine races to date including in all three previous visits to this venue. She now avails of Sam Ewing's 7lb claim in addition to first-time cheekpieces. A breakthrough wouldn't be a surprise. Mosala has run in races won by more than useful sorts (Galileo Chrome and Delphi) and should appreciate this company.

ATR VERDICT: A first-time visor didn't work for TIME AND MONEY last time as he was too free but he drops back to a mile now with cheekpieces fitted, as they had been when he was runner-up three times in a row on his previous outings. One of those creditable efforts was over this distance and he can slot into a handy position from a low draw. Ecliptic Moon was 40/1 when winning over course and distance three weeks ago and, although without Sam Ewing's 7lb claim on this occasion, he can race handily as well and could be capable of further progress. Jack Berry House went close twice before winning cosily here last week. He will probably be played late and is a major player with a good claimer utilised to nullify a 4lb rise in the ratings.

ATR VERDICT: CAMOGUE WOOD was just a neck off subsequent winner St George's Head when fourth over a furlong shorter here last time. Pat Flynn's horses have turned a corner of late and he trained this one's dam, and two siblings, to win at this track. Kevin Manning retains the mount on the Ivawood gelding and the pair can go close in this maiden handicap. Overtake was beaten less than a length in a bunch finish over course and distance last time and has his chance again, as does Irish Ambassador who has plenty of creditable runs in the book over a mile at this venue. Pat Martin was just denied a big-priced double here on Monday and Neyland, not beaten far in fourth here a week ago, is another to consider.

ATR VERDICT: The second division of a maiden handicap but plenty of these have shown racewinning potential. ATR VERDICT: Sheila Lavery was on the mark with the dead-heater Ms Thompson at this venue on Monday and her filly STYLEDOME may be able to follow up an easy win over a furlong further here earlier in the month. The drop in distance should be no problem as she travelled very well before winning readily and the third home, Stop On Red, franked the form with a win next time out. A 12lb rise has to be overcome but she seemed to enjoy a switch to patient tactics last time and connections will be hoping for a solid pace up front. That may be provided by Blue Bunny who led for a long way in a decent-looking maiden last time and could well be competitive on her handicap bow. Bela Boom hasn't shown much but is a half-sister to several useful winners from a top yard which was back amongst the winners itself on Monday and she could easily get involved from a modest mark. Catherine Chroi showed more in first-time headgear last time, has Chris Hayes' assistance off a low weight and going back up to 7f should suit as well.

ATR VERDICT: There should be more to come from the lightly-raced PRISONER'S DILEMMA and he gets the vote despite being unproven on polytrack. Johnny Levins' Toronado gelding showed promise in maidens last year and beat subsequent improver Gee Rex on his handicap bow at Naas in June. His second at Cork when last seen in September was also a good effort. He acts well on good ground so one would hope that the surface here will not be an issue. Course regular Tyrconnell comes here in good form but, with 58 being the highest mark he's won off, he's very much up against it from his new rating of 70. Runner-up in three maidens, including twice at this track, Turbo Command is still open to improvement on his second start for Michael Halford and has run well off a break before, while The Mpex Kid is another Dundalk first-timer to consider with a top claimer riding this 4-year-old who had a good spell of form in 7f handicaps during the summer.
