ATR VERDICT: Flat White will have learned plenty from her hurdling debut against her own sex when a promising second at Uttoxeter, and commands a great deal of respect now running against juveniles. However, she might have to play second fiddle to FIRST IMPRESSION, as he sets the standard on his two runs at the course and this represents a drop in class following his fifth in the Wensleydale. Ranco has had wind surgery since his jumping bow at Southwell and it might help him leave that form well behind.

ATR VERDICT: DOUKAROV improved for the switch back to fences for the first time in the UK when scoring at Taunton earlier in the month and there could be more to come off a 5lb higher rating. ATR VERDICT: Chosen Port was bought for 115,000 pounds shortly after winning an Irish point in March and new connections will be expecting a big run on her NH debut, but ELECTRIC ANNIE might spoil the party.
