






ATR VERDICT: Ritchie Valens ran a solid race on his all-weather return when third here a fortnight ago and was victorious at this venue in June off just 1lb lower. Samille showed promise in three starts last year for Amy Murphy but has a 357-day absence to overcome, and perhaps this can go the way of recent C&D winner DOUBLE REFLECTION. A 5lb penalty makes life tougher, but she dictated the pace here a week ago and could be tough to catch if allowed an uncontested lead.
