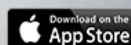
**ATR VERDICT:** AUSTRALIS was deemed good enough to run in the Cesarewitch at Newmarket last month and could capitalise on these much calmer waters for Roger Varian. The four-year-old was previously successful at this venue over a bit further, but has enough tactical speed to cope with this slight drop in distance. 



