Jaboticaba was pulled up at Wincanton eight days ago but had previously shown greater promise at Warwick and Kempton, while Double W's isn't getting any younger but has dropped to a tempting mark.

The five-year-old looked to improve for the step up in trip there and relished the decent ground conditions on offer. Paul Nicholls has enjoyed an excellent season so far and his Flash Collonges is interesting after winning on the same card as the selection earlier this month. Gosheven has had a wind operation and could start to fulfil his early potential for Philip Hobbs now.

ATR VERDICT: A first-time tongue-tie worked the oracle for THE BLACK SQUIRREL in victory at Newcastle two weeks ago and the seven-year-old may have more to offer despite a 6lb rise. Henry Hogarth's charge remains unexposed over 3m and this contest might not take too much winning. Catchmeifyoucan struck at Market Rasen last week and is interesting here under a 7lb penalty for an in-form trainer, while Dubh Des Champs has won over C&D before and returned to form when third at Gosforth Park earlier this month.

ATR VERDICT: Dr Sanderson made a winning reappearance when scoring with ease at Plumpton and he appears likely to be a leading protagonist here, despite a 7lb rise. However, a chance is taken on POGUE, who bumped into the thriving Locks Corner when having to settle for second at Bangor in September and Donald McCain's course-and-distance winner is still unexposed over fences, with first-time cheekpieces now added. Nietzsche (third) has The Unit (fourth) covered from when they met at Wetherby last month and they are others to consider, while Cracking Find steps up in trip having finished third over two miles on the same card.

ATR VERDICT: DONALD DUX romped to an emphatic 10-length victory at Market Rasen in March and although he went up 10lb for that, a wind operation in the interim could bring about plenty more improvement from the six-year-old, who appears to have found his optimum trip. Grand Enterprise has been knocking on the door of late and the 10-year-old course winner remains well handicapped, while Jessica Rabbit has proven herself to be versatile and is only 4lb higher than when second at Market Rasen in September. Hello Bob was a winner at Uttoxeter in the summer and will appreciate a sound surface, with Fraterculus and Chepstow scorer Molliana others to consider.
