

The six-year-old kept on well there and should be staying on when others have had enough over this testing distance. Milanvera is on a tempting mark and could challenge for some prize money.

ATR VERDICT: Rebecca Curtis has her string in good form at the time of writing and perhaps TIME TO FOLLOW can provide the Newport-based handler with another winner. A half-brother to bumper scorer Jeremys Fame, the Flemensfirth gelding won't mind the potential soft ground on offer and could thrive here under talented young rider Richard Patrick. Graeme McPherson is 2-5 in bumpers here since 2015 and Flann should be wiser for his Hereford debut four weeks ago, while Irish Lion could prove best of the newcomers representing Warren Greatrex.
