ATR VERDICT: MONKFISH was one of the leading staying novice hurdlers last season and now makes his eagerly awaited switch to fences. The Stowaway gelding was bought for a sizeable sum by present connections after winning a four-year-old point-to-point and scaled the heights over hurdles last season when showing good battling qualities to land the Albert Bartlett at Cheltenham. Sams Profile is a worthy opponent. He beat Diol Ker in a Cragmore maiden (Monkfish pulled up) and was a smart novice over hurdles when runner-up twice in Grade 1 company. The Mouse Morris-trained gelding missed last season through injury but was jumping well on his reappearance until tipping up at the third last in Thurles. Diol Ker needs to improve his jumping while Ontheropes and Escaria Ten are other interesting rivals.

ATR VERDICT: BRAESIDE hasn't exactly been thrown in on his handicap debut over fences but should give a good account with Lisa O'Neill a big asset in this event. The selection took a maiden hurdle in good style at this venue last winter and has kept some good company since sent chasing this term. His third to stablemate Pencilfulloflead at Galway reads well in light of the winner's subsequent Grade 2 victory, and the addition of cheek-pieces may help him to concentrate. Kavanaghs Corner and Hoke Colburn are both consistent sorts to consider, while Envol Pierji should progress from his reappearance at Down Royal but needs to brush up his jumping. Point-to-point winner Port Rashid has won twice over hurdles and should give Jody Townend a nice spin under a light weight.

ATR VERDICT: SNUGSBOROUGH HALL is certainly better over fences than hurdles and should be spot on for this following an outing last month at Sligo, the form of which has worked out well. The selection has been lightly raced since taking advantage of a nice mark to readily beat Impact Factor at the 2019 Punchestown Festival. Paloma Blue looks the chief threat. The top-weight is a model of consistency and gained the latest of four career wins all at around this trip at Wexford over the summer. He faded after a blunder at the penultimate fence last time when third to Easy Game in the PWC Champion Chase at Gowran Park and this represents a drop in class. There should be no lack of pace with the likes of Yaha Fizz and Us And Them in the line-up. The latter is without a win in two years but has run some fine races in defeat including when placed at the last two Cheltenham Festivals. Gordon Elliott is bidding to win this race for the third successive year and riding arrangements suggest Timoteo is the pick of his trio. However, the former Alan King-trained gelding needs to step up on his Irish debut at Down Royal to take a hand.

ATR VERDICT: So impressive in the mares' novice hurdle at the Cheltenham Festival when last seen, CONCERTISTA gets the vote to win for the first time on Irish soil. Just touched off in the corresponding race at Cheltenham a year earlier, when making her hurdling debut, she hasn't won over this trip but she bounded up the hill in March so it's hard to see that being a problem. Minella Melody was too keen and dropped out of contention behind the selection at Cheltenham but is a far better mare than that. She won her first three over hurdles, stays well and should benefit from having had a recent run when second to a smart sort in Beacon Edge at Galway. Cheltenham bumper third Queens Brook made a winning start over hurdles at this track last month and, along with several rivals, got racing from too far out when mugged late by an outsider at Down Royal. She's better than that bare form and will probably be ridden with more restraint on this occasion.

ATR VERDICT: HOOK UP travelled well for a long way on her Irish debut, over course and distance in February, before finishing third in a Grade 3 won by stablemate Burning Victory. While the latter progressed from that run to take advantage of Goshen's misfortune at the last in the Triumph Hurdle, Hook Up didn't run any sort of race on that occasion. A 1m4f winner on the Flat in France last year, she holds a Grade 1 entry at Christmas and can leave behind her Cheltenham disappointment. Gars De Sceaux beat Magic Tricks (fourth in a Punchestown bumper last month) in a point-to-point after which both horses were bought by JP McManus and joined Gordon Elliott. He's of obvious interest along with Gigolo'Dai Dai who cost plenty at last year's Derby Sale and is a half-brother to Paul Nicholls' three-time winner Diamond Guy. Legacy Thor has experience but would prefer further and will most likely find a couple too good.

ATR VERDICT: KESKONRISK was bought by high-profile owner Mike Grech for £370,000 after winning a bumper at this track on New Year's Day. He had a couple of subsequent winners behind him that day, including recent useful maiden hurdle scorer Gabynako, and can make a winning start for new trainer Joseph O'Brien. A Grade 1 entry at Christmas indicates that connections have high hopes for the half-brother to smart hurdler/chaser Grand Sancy. Indigo Breeze won a Thurles bumper in good style last month and is an obvious danger coming from such a powerful yard. Smart Flat horse Still Standing ran well when second at Gowran behind a fair sort in One Down before dropping out tamely last time at Down Royal and it remains to be seen what level he can attain over hurdles, while Henry de Bromhead's Presenting newcomer Innovated is another to bear in mind.

ATR VERDICT: There might be a handicap in ONE FOR JOE from a reasonable mark and off a nice enough racing weight. He has garnered a fair bit of experience at this stage and may reverse Sligo form with Desire De Joie, who's blinkered for the first time after being soundly beaten on his handicap bow at Clonmel. King Alex is on a hat-trick and comes from a stable in great form, while Jiving Jerry has been most consistent and the winner slipped the field to some extent when he was runner-up to Make Good at Gowran last time. Wingin A Prayer wasn't far behind the smart Sneaky Getaway at this course last time although it was a slowly-run affair and the form might be a little dubious. At The Acorn was a useful chaser last season and, after a couple of recent outings, could get involved under a good claimer while Call A Cab showed up well on his first run for over a year at Navan and is another to consider.

ATR VERDICT: FISTON DES ISSARDS ran well when second to a useful mare in Tucanae in a maiden hurdle at this track a couple of weeks ago. When he won his only start in point-to-points last year he had subsequent British bumper winners behind him in second and fourth. Running in his first bumper here, he'll be hard to beat unless there's a smart one in the opposition.
