









That said, preference is for HIGHWAY ONE O TWO, who won a Grade 2 over hurdles last season and he is surely capable of better than what he showed at Ffos Las last time. All of the rest have claims but Cheddleton is arguably the pick of them.

With that in mind, the son of Coastal Path is hard to oppose this afternoon, despite having to carry a 6lb penalty. Legends Ryde brings solid form to the table and could prove to be the main threat to the selection, ahead of Honor Grey and Wetlands.

Happy Diva was in the process of running another solid race in the Paddy Power Gold Cup when falling at Cheltenham a couple of weeks ago, while My Old Gold is better than what she showed in Lincolnshire last time when pulled up in the same race as the selection.

ATR VERDICT: RATH AN IUIR made a winning start to life over fences here at the beginning of the month and is open to further improvement for the step up in distance off a 6lb higher mark. Ashfield Paddy was progressive over hurdles last season and shaped on his chase debut at Chepstow as though he would benefit from the outing, while similar comments apply to Sirwilliamwallace based on his fifth at Wetherby on his return to the track.

ATR VERDICT: GUARDINO cost 170,000 pounds at the Cheltenham sale in February having finished second on his sole point-to-point outing at Oldtown and he is of considerable interest making his debut under Rules. Aviewtosea found one too strong when running well in a Chepstow bumper last month and he warrants plenty of respect along with Here We Have It, who boasts plenty of experience from the pointing field.
