The 122-rated Fearless is better than showing at Ascot last time and will benefit from Fergus Gregory's valuable claim, while Get With It can build on a promising first spin over timber at Carlisle.

**ATR VERDICT:** UNOHU did well in bumpers last season (winning on heavy ground at Newcastle first time out) and made a bright start to his hurdling career when chasing home the useful Shakem Up'Arry at Ffos Las 22 days ago. He is entitled to improve for that experience and can go one better, possibly at the main expense of Happy Hollow, who didn't appear to get home over an extended 2m4f here last time, and Sandy Thomson's French import Fantastic Rock.

**ATR VERDICT:** O'HANRAHAN BRIDGE certainly wasn't winning out of turn over a similar trip at Carlisle three weeks ago and with that confidence booster under his belt, he rates the one to beat despite a 5lb rise. With Danny McMenamin's claim taken into consideration, Legalized is effectively 2lb better off than when three-parts of a length second over an extended 2m4f here last time and she could be in the mix again, while the dropped-in-class Skipthescales cannot be ruled out either.

**ATR VERDICT:** Skandiburg is very well treated at these weights and has to be respected, but he was disappointing on his chasing debut at Fakenham last month so might be worth taking on. Nicky Richards saddles a couple of interesting runners in Mayo Star and Skiddaw Tara, with jockey bookings pointing to the former being the first string, while Hear No Evil cannot be ruled out following his comfortable Wetherby win. However, EMPIRE STEEL impressed when scoring on his fencing bow over an extended 2m4f here five weeks ago and he shades the verdict.

**ATR VERDICT:** CALIVIGNY bolted up over fences here last month and reverts to hurdles off just a 4lb higher mark. Nick Alexander's gelding is unlikely to be improving massively at the ripe old age of 11, but the manner of his recent success suggests he's in great form at present.
