ATR VERDICT: DASH OF BLUE gamely justified favouritism when winning over an extended 2m4f at Southwell last time and a 4lb rise might not be enough to anchor this progressive five-year-old. Andapa only found subsequent winner Midnight Glance too good on her seasonal reappearance at Plumpton four weeks ago and she is likely to be in the shake-up again, while Blazing Saddles and Ermy'n's Emerald are other names to note.
