ATR VERDICT: PALM BEACH can make a winning hurdles debut. By Galileo, he showed smart ability on the flat for Aidan O'Brien and having beaten two useful types when winning at Listowel in September, comes here proven on testing ground and over staying trips. He will be well schooled and this if he brings his flat form, should prove hard to beat. Crassus has the advantage of having had three previous hurdle starts which is a big help to his chances. He was fairly useful on the flat and while he can be relied upon to run another sound race over hurdles today, is also vulnerable to any smart prospects. On Guard was also useful on the flat but jumped dreadfully at Killarney in October and today debuts in a hood. He is best watched.

ATR VERDICT: CARROLLS COTTAGE is a somewhat speculative pick to beat the Willie Mullins-trained French import Rambrant'jac. A 4yo maiden point-to-point winner at Dromahane in October, CARROLLS COTTAGE ran a promising race when second at Cork recently, when staying-on quite well from a little off the pace to finish second to a smart winner. The third-placed horses (whom he gave 7lbs to) is rated 120 and CARROLLS COTTAGE looks sure to improve for the step back up in trip. Rambrant'jac was a non-runner as a reserve at Thurles last Thursday and is clearly a very notable Irish import. He was fifth on his flat debut in August 2019 and filled third on his only other run in a Bordeaux hurdle the following month. He makes his reappearance following a 434-day absence today and while he could well be anything, will at least need to be quite useful to beat the selection. Hardwired has shown form and comes here in good health, having been placed on testing ground on his most recent starts. He can be relied upon to run another sound race but should struggle to win. An Taibhse is out of an unraced dam who is related to some staying winners and while she represents a top yard, will need to be smart to win on debut. Similarly Champagne Izzy, a half-sister to a hurdle winner, runs in a first-time hood for her debut over hurdles and is best watched for now.

ATR VERDICT: CASTLEGRANGE can prove best. A close fourth on his only 2019 point-to-point run, he initially failed to show much over hurdles but ran a very promising race when second at Fairyhouse last January. He was well held by winner Aarons Day but that horse won again next-time, is now rated 125 which suggests CASTLEGRANGE is better than his current 103 rating. He was brought down at halfway at Wexford last month but may have derived some benefit from that away-day and has ideal conditions today. More Info is a useful and consistent type who ran a solid race when second here recently. She is ground-versatile and should prove competitive from her rating and might confirm recent course form with Lauderdale Lady. Beating The Odds has done well in handicaps recently and should get involved despite racing from a career mark of 101. Elusive Star stays well and likes testing ground but might bump into a few too strong while Buck Rogers has a very ordinary jumping technique and might do well to defy top weight.

ATR VERDICT: FENNO'S STORM has been hit with a 12lbs penalty for winning over course and distance recently but might defy the rise and win. A nine-time point-to-point and dual hunter chase winner, he made use of a low hurdle rating here recently while he was fairly laboured in winning, can still be relied upon to go well in this similar race, with his same rider able to utilise his full 7lbs claim today (he claimed 4lbs previously). Classic Concorde was a 27L winner of a handicap chase at Fairyhouse recently and was penalised 12lbs for that chase win. He had previously looked fairly exposed but did record a wide-margin success at Kilbeggan last year while he was unlucky not to win at Down Royal last November when incurring an injury jumping the final flight. Rudy Catrail is another interesting runner given how capable he is of winning from the front at this level. He disappointed on his latest chase run but has obvious claims on his best form. Live Every Day is 5lbs higher than when winning at Clonmel 33 days ago but can again get involved while Allbarone is reasonably interesting on handicap debut having finished second in an unplaced maiden at Wexford latest. Werethewindsblow wasn't beaten far at Punchestown 17 days ago and can get involved if he continues to progress.

ATR VERDICT: Given that his Listowel rout came on testing ground, it was perhaps surprising to see COSTALOTMORE so strong in the market on much different terrain at Cork last time. He had a first time hood on at Mallow, and that headgear is dispensed with now. The dual point-to-point looks sure to enjoy this assignment of two miles five on heavy ground better. He has to concede weight away all round but a bold bid seems sure to come from Mikey Fogarty's mount on his hurdles debut. He was sidelined at one stage for 520 days and the selection can continue to make up for lost time. Captain Mc, En Beton and Fissa are among the others that need to be kept in mind.

ATR VERDICT: Three last-time-out scorers line up here and it might not be a bad idea to focus in on Spancil Hill, Vipers Nest and BALLYSHANNON ROSE. Vipers Nest scored over this track and trip a fortnight back and he's off a 5lb higher mark now for beating Glenabo Bridge (in opposition again) by half a length. Spancil Hill triumphed over fences at Clonmel 19 days back. His rating of 95 here, compares favourably to 105 for his chasing endeavours. Ballyshannon Rose got 8lb for a nice success at Thurles last Thursday and has to be of interest now shouldering a mandatory 5lb penalty. Aaron Fahey is up to help with his 2lb claim and a progressive and in-form mare like the selection is always easy to row in behind.

ATR VERDICT: Nobody will be taking BELLE LURETTE too lightly, given the exploits of the same connections bumper horses this autumn. For owner William MacDonald and trainer Liam Burke a pair of four-year-olds, namely Teuchters Glory and Gordon Dai Dai, made winning debuts at Galway. Maybe it's a bit much to be expecting lightning to strike for a third time but Belle Lurette is eye-catching as a half-sister to Saturday's exciting winner Keskonrisk. Another out of the Risk Seeker mare, the dam, La Courtille, is a very decent sort as well. That's Paul Nicholls' Grand Sancy and if Belle Lurette can perform anything like as well as her siblings she's got to be taken very seriously. Upstate New York native Jeannie Cook won't be any hindrance in the plate either. Granny Lowrie only recently lost a Kilbeggan maiden hurdle win from August, after a banned substance was detected in a sample. She has to be seen as a big danger to all.
