**ATR VERDICT:** LITTLE RORY MAC looks the one to be on in a tricky finale for punters to solve. The unexposed six-year-old wasn't able to cope with the step up in trip at Plumpton last time but goes on the ground and will be a lot more at home over 2m. He is lightly raced in handicaps and was so impressive when beating a 121-rated gelding by five lengths in novice company at Kelso earlier in the year.
