ATR VERDICT: RAVENSCAR had been threatening to strike for a while and duly obliged over C&D three weeks ago for Phil Kirby. A 4lb rise doesn't leave him overburdened, and the four-year-old could strike again granted another prominent ride. Rukwa beat a few of these when second over C&D last month and could go close again under Graham Lee, while Thawry seldom runs a bad race on the all-weather but remains 12lb above his last winning mark.

ATR VERDICT: Castlebar has had three chances to open his account now without success and the fact that connections turn to first-time cheekpieces suggests that the gelding isn't entirely straightforward. Kondo Isami only found one too good on debut over C&D last month, though he was beaten far enough there, and perhaps this can go to BANDINELLI on his first outing for Charlie Appleby. A brother to Group 1 winner Old Persian, this trip will be a minimum for him given time and this looks a suitable opening for the Dubawi colt.

ATR VERDICT: Taravara is becoming expensive to follow but wasn't beaten far when third at Lingfield in October and wears blinkers now trying Tapeta for the first time. Counsel's dam won over this distance on the all-weather and he needs a betting check on debut for John Gosden, though it might be worth looking at the William Haggas-trained newcomer, FIREWORKS. An 850,000-euro yearling, the son of Kingman is a half-brother to three winners and his handler has an excellent record here with juveniles.
