ATR VERDICT: Coqueta didn't seem to enjoy her Fibresand experience at Southwell in November but previously showed potential both here and at Haydock and could easily bounce back. My Boy Sepoy would be dangerous if granted a strong early gallop, but this can go the way of THANIELLE. Fourth over C&D last month, this is just her third start for Alan King and the Nathaniel filly is seriously unexposed over middle distances. She has been dropped a further 1lb since she was last seen and could take advantage.

ATR VERDICT: COOL TO BE A CAT won on Tapeta over this distance at Wolverhampton last month and would be hard to beat if transferring that form to Polytrack. ATR VERDICT: NELSON RIVER was successful at Wolverhampton six days ago in a race for apprentice riders and arrives here off the same mark as a result under Elisha Whittington.
