**ATR VERDICT:** KEANE'S KINGDOM wasn't beaten far despite only finishing fifth at Wolverhampton last month and could take the necessary step forward given his unexposed profile for Archie Watson. The four-year-old wears a visor for the first time and is surely capable of being very competitive off a mark of 58. Contingency Fee has been shaping well in defeat at Southwell this winter and could do better on Polytrack, while Jan Wellens has struggled over hurdles so far this winter but looks fairly handicapped back on the level.
