









**ATR VERDICT:** BLACK CENTAUR always looked to be in control when scoring over a similar trip at Plumpton last time and is expected to defy a 3lb rise in the ratings to follow up. Bellamy's Grey picked up minor money over a similar distance at Wincanton last time and is unlikely to be fazed by this 1lb higher mark. Another to consider is Colonel Manderson, who steps up in trip after being outpaced over 2m3f at Exeter last time.

**ATR VERDICT:** ALL THE GLORY's dam won on the Flat in Germany so perhaps she will have enough pace to claim this prize for Jonjo O'Neill.
