ATR VERDICT: WEST BALBOA ran no sort of race in the Long Walk at Ascot just before Christmas but otherwise boasts a near exemplary record under Rules, so looks worth forgiving that below-par display. A line of form through Brewin'upastorm gives the Dan Skelton-trained mare a live chance of coping with the challenge presented by Marie's Rock, who rates a big player despite conceding 2lb to the selection. Coquelicot is the pick of the rest, with her stamina more proven than You Wear It Well at this stage.
