


He had plenty in hand first time out and his classy breeding suggests that there is much more to come over this longer trip for a top stable. The biggest threats look to be the Joseph O'Brien pair North Coast and Green Soul. The former is the first string on jockey bookings and has seen his debut form franked at Group level so holds strong claims while his stablemate is expected to reverse previous form with Leblon Queen.
