The 400,000gns Fastnet Rock filly, half-sister to Old Glory who was very smart over 10f, represents a stable in form and is likely to go well. Also in the mix is Goodwood Mogul, who ran to form when third in a 10f handicap at Salisbury. He's effective from 8f to 10f and handles ground with some give. Completing the trio is Return To Unit, who would have won but for hanging under pressure when second at Lingfield last time, effective at 1m and seemingly unlucky not to have opened his account and with more to come.

Expert View: Showed a modest debut but displayed a good attitude when beaten 9 1/2l in a novice over 7f at Chelmsford; bred to want 7/8f and didn't show much ability on debut.

EXPERT VIEW: ICENI QUEEN is hard to look past in this 2yo fillies race. She wasn't given a hard time and finished well when fourth in a novice at Chelmsford on debut; she's middledistance bred, but effective over 1m and a big filly with plenty to come. Also on the shortlist is strong debut performer Ziata, who produced a solid effort when runner-up in a Haydock novice over 7f and looks promising. Third best could be :Moon Is Up, who tired badly after being made too much use of when well beaten on debut at Leicester; she's bred to want 10f and moves as though that trip will suit but could improve enough to make the frame regardless.

EXPERT VIEW: A difficult-to-assess contest where the preference is for GAMRAI. He would have finished 2–3l closer if ridden out when second in a novice at Epsom last time and looks an effective 10f performer on a sound surface. He's well bred with more to come. Also worth consideration is Mr Alan, who ran to form when beaten at Pontefract last time, having previously won this race in both 2022 and 2023; he is effective at 10f, handles any ground, though is best with some cut, and remains generally consistent. Third best could be King's Code, who ran to form when landing an 11f handicap at Kempton, though his new mark could prove slightly demanding.
