**EXPERT VIEW:** BONNIE'S BOY improved on recent handicap efforts to open his account last time over CD and, now that he's rediscovered the kind of levels shown as a juvenile, is worth keeping on side despite the rise in grade and the 8lb extra for that ready win. Paul Midgley has won two of the last five runnings of this race and is represented by Lethal Nymph who arrives in fine form and was placed the last twice he ran here (over 6f and 5f). The six-year-old is feared most. Bright, a no-show in the Ayr Bronze Cup last time, can get back on track in this less deep race returned to a track that suits well and Mark Loughnane's CD winner could reward each way support
