EXPERT VIEW: Top-weight CORAMENTO looks a solid option in an othwerwise tight affair. David Thompson's four-year-old won over CD last time and should be tough to master off just a 3lb rise. Concert Boy should put up a decent challenge having gone well over a mile the last twice but even better over 7f prior to that, and a return to this shorter trip should see him to better effect. Urban Dandy has rediscovered his mojo after two poor runs off a layoff since Spring and has some solid form at this level at the track. He can get in the mix and challenge for a place at least
