EXPERT VIEW: MOLINARI rarely fails to give best and sprung back to form last time after a rare blip prior (possibly needed the run off a break) when placed over CD, beaten little over a length. Mark Todhunter's gelding goes well here, with two wins and four places from eight runs, including when winning this event last year off a 2lb lower mark. He should go well again and challenge for top honours. Runninsonofagun has been in the top four on six of his last seven runs and is interesting tried over 1m2f for the first time, as he's been flattening out over a mile but perhaps is just lacking a gear at the trip and earlier in his career looked like this trip may suit. He could be worth chancing, while Without Compromise is in flying form after a win and a close second over CD the last twice and has to be feared




