**ATR VERDICT:** In a moderate event, marginal preference is for GOODBYEMICK, who has been running well enough in defeat of late over hurdles to suggest that he can go well in a race of this nature. Rip Wheeler would be a big threat based on his narrow second over timber here in April if he's ready to go after a break, while Crac De Megaudais is the pick of the remainder.
