Fern Hill ended a losing run at Uttoxeter last time and he remains fairly treated off a 3lb higher mark, but he goes particularly well at that Midlands venue and faces a tougher ask against the selection this time.

A pair of also-rans from the Grade 2 Mares' bumper at Aintree's Grand National meeting back in April look likely to give her most to do, with Blue Betty preferred to Amelia's Star as the danger. Blue Betty finished lame in that Aintree contest and represents a yard that has won this for the past two years, with there being a suspicion Amelia's Star may need further to be seen at her best.

EXPERT VIEW: The only mare in the field, KINGSTON SUNFLOWER excels on a flat, righthanded circuit and still looks feasily treated, with her capable rider's claim a help. She wouldn't want rain, but looks the one to beat if it stays away. Charging Thunder should do better than at Cheltenham last time, his first run over hurdles since December, with the return to a flatter track very much in his favour. He's still got potential from this mark, given his Flat rating. Although his recent runs are nothing to get excited about, Castel Gandolfo has had his excuses and finds himself just below his last winning mark. He could go well at a price.
