EXPERT VIEW:

Having thrived under an attacking ride at Fakenham last time, it would be no surprise to see ENJOY D'ALLEN follow up, despite a 7lb rise. He's not the horse he once was, but still looks to hold a class edge over his rivals. The absence is of no concern for Fuji Flight, given his trainer Venetia Williams is a dab hand at getting one ready, but he wasn't in the best of form when last seen in the spring and may have liked softer ground. Fern Hill ended a losing run at Uttoxeter last time and he remains fairly treated off a 3lb higher mark, but he goes particularly well at that Midlands venue and faces a tougher ask against the selection this time.
