ATR VERDICT: ENJOY D'ALLEN made every yard of the running to score by 10 lengths in this grade at Fakenham last month and even a 7lb rise might underestimate the manner of that success. If in similar form, he will prove a tough nut to crack. Fern Hill was victorious at Uttoxeter on his most recent outing and is just 3lb higher, so would be foolish to dismiss. Fuji Flight can beat Zacony Rebel home for third.


ATR VERDICT: KINGSTON SUNFLOWER was an impressive six-length winner on her return to hurdling at Ludlow a month ago and Fergal O'Brien's mare is hard to oppose on the back of that effort, despite a 7lb rise. Diesel Line placed at Uttoxeter most recently after winning at the same venue in September and he is an obvious danger, while He's A Latchico and Charging Thunder should not be underestimated.
