He caused a shock that day but there was no fluke about it as he beat numerous previous winners so he isn't ruled out under a penalty. He could however be vulnerable to a talented newcomer such as HARRY LOWES. The selection was a winner in a point last time and has since joined top connections. He will have more to offer under rules and gets the verdict ahead of Aguellid who shaped well on his only start in France which has been boosted at Listed level.

EXPERT VIEW: A strong race can go to LULAMBA who proved himself top class as a juvenile hurdler last time finishing an unlucky second in the Triumph before making amends at Punchestown. His trainer has always held him in the highest regard and suggested that there would be more to come in this sphere. Salver would probably ideally want slightly further than this on easier ground but he sets the standard on ratings on his best hurdles form so looks the obvious danger. Tripoli Flyer was also a Graded winner over hurdles and was going well when departing on his chase debut. If his jumping holds up he can also make his presence felt.

That form has had some knocks but she should provide the biggest challenge ahead of Betty's Daisy who was also highly tried in bumpers following a debut victory.

EXPERT VIEW: An open race where REALLYNTRUTHFULLY may be able to follow up on his debut victory. He beat some more experienced rivals in decisive fashion that day and has only gone up 7lb. Pony Soprano went off too quickly on his chase debut but was far from disgraced by a rival who franked the form at Listed level over the weekend. If ridden slightly more conservatively he can chase the selection home ahead of the highly regarded That's Nice. The mare was 2-3 over hurdles and likely has more to offer in this sphere for top connections.
