EXPERT VIEW: A strong race can go to LULAMBA who proved himself top class as a juvenile hurdler last time finishing an unlucky second in the Triumph before making amends at Punchestown. His trainer has always held him in the highest regard and suggested that there would be more to come in this sphere. Salver would probably ideally want slightly further than this on easier ground but he sets the standard on ratings on his best hurdles form so looks the obvious danger. Tripoli Flyer was also a Graded winner over hurdles and was going well when departing on his chase debut. If his jumping holds up he can also make his presence felt.

EXPERT VIEW: Point winner SPECIAL JOHN proved consistent in his short hurdling career and could now get off the mark under rules switched to the larger obstacles. He recorded a rating higher than his current mark on his penultimate start over hurdles and the form of that race has worked out well. Top weight Mythe Bridge has gone close on both starts over fences so far so looks the obvious danger while Fat Faced Columbo is also of interest at a bigger price. He shaped like a stayer on his last hurdles run and it is notable that the yard switches him to fences so quickly in his career.
