Expert View: Scored a touch cosily despite looking a little quirky in a hood when a 1/21 winner in a maiden here on debut. Effective at 7f; possibly not the most straightforward but there is more to come.★★★★★ (Forecast 4/7)

Expert View: Badly outpaced when comfortably held in a novice here last time. Bred to want 10f; a big gelding who looks to be crying out for 8f or further.★★★★★ (Forecast 25/1)

Expert View: Dark Angel gelding; dam French 8f winner, half-sister to winners Impulsif and Veil Of Shadows, both Group performers; dam useful at 8f; trainer in form and likely go well on debut.★★★★★ (Forecast 7/4)

Expert View: Green and missed the break when showing nothing and finishing well beaten in a maiden here on his only start. Speed on the sire's side and more stamina on the dam's side; all to prove after a poor debut.★★★★★ (Forecast 20/1)

Expert View: Awkward at the start and green under pressure when well beaten in a maiden at Kempton latest. Bred for around 7f and looks the type to do better in handicaps.★★★★★

**EXPERT VIEW:** Horwich made a winning debut over C&D, albeit not looking straightforward in a hood, but there's likely still more to come from him. Whether he can defy a penalty if the newcomer KOKUSHOKU runs to a mark in the mid-70s on debut remains to be seen, however. His dam is related to Group performers and this is taken to make a winning debut for his good yard. Big Moonrise is third on the list, although looks an unlikely winner, at least until he's in handicaps.
