EXPERT VIEW:

Horwich made a winning debut over C&D, albeit not looking straightforward in a hood, but there's likely still more to come from him. Whether he can defy a penalty if the newcomer KOKUSHOKU runs to a mark in the mid-70s on debut remains to be seen, however. His dam is related to Group performers and this is taken to make a winning debut for his good yard. Big Moonrise is third on the list, although looks an unlikely winner, at least until he's in handicaps.
