**Jockey Colours:** Royal blue, beige hoop and sleeves, white cap  
**Expert View:** Cheekpieces are worn for the first time after running about to the balance of her form when beaten 7f into third in a handicap at Lingfield last time. She wants 6f or further and needs to find more. (Forecast 12/1)

**Jockey Colours:** Light blue, orange epaulets  
**Expert View:** Ran about to form but made plenty of use of when beaten 4f off a 3lb higher mark at Lingfield last time. A tongue-tie is applied for the first time, although he has a wide draw and the mark looks stiff. (Forecast 10/1)

**Jockey Colours:** Yellow and light blue check, white and yellow striped sleeves, yellow and light blue quartered cap  
**Expert View:** Was a no-show from off the pace when tried in a hood and well beaten in a maiden at Chelmsford latest. Blinkers are fitted for the first time, but she is a big, strong sort with only ordinary runs so far. (Forecast 8/1)

**Jockey Colours:** Dark blue, white hooped sleeves, white cap  
**Expert View:** Produced a poor effort, perhaps not staying, when well beaten in a handicap at Lingfield last time. Effective at 7f, but her form has deteriorated rapidly and she needs to arrest that decline. (Forecast 66/1)

**Jockey Colours:** Beige, brown chevron, hooped sleeves and spots on cap  
**Expert View:** Made too much use of and was very disappointing when well beaten in a handicap at Lingfield latest. She had been in good form beforehand and is on a competitive mark for this drop back to 6f. (Forecast 14/1)

**Jockey Colours:** Light green, black triple diamond, diamonds on sleeves, light green cap, black diamond  
**Expert View:** Made too much use of but ran to the balance of her form when beaten 6 1/4f in a maiden at Dundalk last time. She had been in good form prior, but looks exposed as ordinary despite this being a weak race. (Forecast 8/1)

**Jockey Colours:** White, dark blue chevrons, white sleeves, dark blue stars, white cap, dark blue star  
**Expert View:** Put in a fine effort despite going fast early when beaten 3 1/4f off a 1lb higher mark at Southwell last time. Her trainer is in form, she is suited by 6f, and she looks on a fair mark. (Forecast 5/2)

**Jockey Colours:** Light green, black hoops, black sleeves, light green armlets  
**Expert View:** Made too much use of when back from a break and beaten 7f in a handicap at Southwell last time. He was tried in a tongue-tie latest and has yet to show much ability. (Forecast 10/1)

**EXPERT VIEW:** FORCEFUL LADY wasn't seen to best effort at Lingfield last time, being made too much use of over 7f, but she'd earlier looked a little unfortunate over this trip at Chelmsford and is taken to bounce back to form. Luna Beaux, formerly trained in Ireland, holds a fair chance on the pick of her form provided she runs to her best on this stable debut. Oh So Perfect is coming off a good third at Southwell and needs considering also in an open little race.
