EXPERT VIEW: There Runs Mary may benefit from the drop in trip, especially with the ground so testing, but REINADO appeals more in his bid for a hat-trick. He won well at both Uttoxeter and Chepstow in the space of a week in November and, although returning off a 14lb higher mark, it would be a surprise were 107 the ceiling of his ability.
