Expert View: Did it readily when running to form on stable debut, winning a maiden hurdle at Ffos Las by 2l last time. Returning from a break and effective over 2m2f-2m5f, with more to come for this yard.★★★★☆ (Forecast 4/1)

Expert View: Bit below form when eighth, beaten 14l off 106 last time, and runs off the same mark here. Tongue-tie is applied for the first time and he is effective at 2m-2m2f, but others are preferred.★★★★☆ (Forecast 13/2)

Expert View: Ran to form but did not get home on deep ground when comfortably held in a handicap hurdle at Ffos Las last time. Effective around 2m-2m5f, though the ground is again a concern.★★★★☆ (Forecast 8/1)

Expert View: Did it cosily and improved again when landing a handicap by 12l off a 13lb lower mark at Lingfield last time. Effective over 2m4f-3m2f and hugely progressive, he may defy his new mark despite a rise in grade.★★★★☆ (Forecast 5/4)

EXPERT VIEW: This is a competitive little race. Stamina is sure to be at a premium and that may suit BOLLIN THOU ideally given he was a winner over almost 3m2f earlier in January. He's up 13lb in his bid for a four-timer, and is also up in class, but still receives weight from all and shouldn't have any issue with the ground conditions. Tennessee Tango is a likely improver now handicapping over a longer trip, having shaped promising in qualifying runs, while Precious Metal certainly shaped as though this trip would suit when getting up late to win a maiden hurdle at Lingfield last time.
