EXPERT VIEW: Rip Wheeler could easily return to form tried in blinkers, with his stable always commanding utmost respect here, but NORN IRON appeals more. Although a little underwhelming at Windsor last time, he seemed to find hings happening too quickly on the dry ground and getting back on a deeper surface over a longer trip could unlock improvment, with a tongue-tie also added. Soldierofthestorm should improve on his chase debut, when second at Hereford, but a bigger threat may come from Mon Champion, who lookd to be crying out for this trip when up late to win last time. Almost all of his penalty is offset by his rider's claim.
