**EXPERT VIEW:** MERCI MAM showed a high level of form when making a winning debut in France and could follow up on his first start for his new yard. He's proven on testing ground and gets weight from his main rival Aqua Bleu who showed a good turn of foot when beating a modest field last time. Perhaps the most interesting opponent is Mwabani who finished runner up to a future Grade 2 winner on debut. He went off favourite that day so is likely thought capable of much better.
