**ATR VERDICT:** Having made light work of her rivals at Huntingdon recently, it's difficult to look beyond DELTA BLUES BELLE. The six-year-old travelled sweetly upped markedly in distance that day and a 7lb penalty is unlikely to stop her progress. The most resistance may be served by the unexposed Walkinthepresent, who finished third on his handicap bow at Uttoxeter last month, ahead of Klic Boum.
