EXPERT VIEW: Plenty of runners but not many appeal. LOUSTIC DU CHATEL is one of the few who does, however, improving for the change in tactics when allowed to stride on at Huntingdon last time. He is still a little immature and tends to race keenly but there's nothing of the calibre of his conqueror last time, Double Measure, in this line-up. Aguellid is consistent but he too races keenly and was probably dropped a little too far off the pace last time when runner-up here. He's got a bigger effort in him still as does the mare Aj's Diamond, although she may not be at her best until upped to 2m4f. Tap Tap Shamie was off the mark at the second in points and has joined a good yard, so it'll be interesting to see which way he goes in the betting.
